

2024-2025 Cheerleading Tryouts Process

Online Cheerleading Application must be completed no later than 11:59 pm on Friday, April 12.

Clinics:

- All material will be learned at the tryout clinics on Monday and Tuesday.
- We will have an open gym for candidates to practice on the mats.
- If you are unable to attend one or both days, please contact a coach immediately.

Clinic Days:

- All candidates will learn a chant and cheer and review our school fight song.
- All candidates will have the opportunity to review correct placement of motions, jumps, tumbling, etc.

DO NOT attempt ANY tumbling skills that you have not done previously

Tryout Number:

- All Candidates will receive their tryout number on Tuesday, at the tryout clinic.
- Tryout groups will be assigned at this time.

Tryouts:

- All tryouts will take place on Friday, starting at 3:30 in the MHS gym.
- Candidates will try out with their group, after arriving promptly at a designated time to warm-up before their try out.
- Following their group's tryout, applicants are allowed to leave.

A current physical must be on file with the athletic department prior to being allowed to practice

Character References

- Please use the link included in the online application for 3 character references.

-These can be anyone who would know you in a mentor like setting

Tryout Appearance:

- Apparel black shorts, a **plain** white t-shirt (no graphics or words), no show socks, & white tennis shoes.
- All hair must be pulled up and completely away from the face in a ponytail with a plain ribbon.
- No beads, headbands, or hair clips other than bobby pins may be worn.
- No jewelry (including nose and belly button rings) and no nail polish or fake nails. These will be checked.

Tryouts Procedure:

- Candidates will be judged on the tryout material by a panel of outside judges on the following: -Motions - Jumps - Dance - Technique - Crowd Appeal -Tumbling
- Candidates Final Tryout Score will be compiled as:
 - Score from each tryout judge (sample score sheet attached) and character reference points

Results / Following Tryouts:

- Results will be posted on both the BAND app and the Marysville Monarch Cheer social media Friday evening.
- You can access the website at www.marysvillemonarchcheer.weebly.com
- The results will be listed by squad and name.
- Candidates will receive a form with tips for improving and notes from the tryout upon request.
- If selected to a squad, coaches will invite you to that squad's specific BAND group by April 26 and more information will be shared at that time.
- Apparel Fittings will be Monday, April 29 time TBD

- Signed commitment page and \$100 camp deposit due April 29

If you have any other questions following the tryouts - please email coaches.

- Please wait a minimum of 24 hours before responding to coaches
- Coaches WILL NOT answer any phone calls, texts or BAND messages in regards to tryouts
- Coaches will ONLY answer emails in regards to tryouts that are received more than 24 hours following tryouts
